#### **Update from Mark Duwyn**

- Welcome and thanks from Mark.
- Spring Break confirmed, April 12-16th.
- Unsure if school will return after break, but communication from the TDSB is to be ready to pivot to virtual school.
- Huge increase in kids and parents wearing masks outside. Spare masks available in the office if needed.
- Reminder to students to bring water bottles to school. The school has run out of cups a few times.
- Health forms must be completed each day. Approximately 12 students each day are coming to school without forms. The office is really busy following up with screenings. Frances is getting her steps in!
- Tech if pivoting it will need to be distributed. There has been new purchases of ipads and chromebooks to support school learning.
- Playground committee the school is happy with the progress.
- Staffing for next year 524 students, down from last year.
   Planning for back to classrooms in September.
- Expecting the structure 30 minute lunch, rotary teachers less rotation, 2 breaks.
- Due to staffing challenges (isolating due to Covid etc), the school is pulling from art/sports to cover classes.
